What we collect

Why we need the information we gather

We require this information for the following reasons:

- When on our website to collect statistics, traffic patterns and related site information. We aggregate this data and it does not identify any website users. We use it for research, analysis, testing, monitoring, risk management and administrative purposes

How we keep it

All the personal data we process is processed by our staff located in Glasgow, Scotland. We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. The organisation will hold personal data on its own IT network and its SiteGround server where the data is located in the EU.

How long we keep it for

We will hold your data for as long as required. Any other data stored on our server is deleted once a month.

How we use cookies

Cookies are small text files stored on your device and used by website operators in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the operators of the website or certain third parties. Each cookie usually contains a unique string of characters, which allows a website to distinguish your browser or device from other users.
